### **Municipality of Matosinhos**

On October 30th, the Biodiversity, Ecosystems and Natural Capital Strategy of the Municipality of Matosinhos was presented. This strategy was developed under the Green City Accord and was supported by NBI. In summary, 3 strategic axes were highlighted: the safeguarding of Biodiversity and Native Habitats, Ecological Restoration and Green and Blue Infrastructures, all of them as fundamental aspects for the implementation of Nature Based Solutions in an urban environment.





# PRIMA BONEX - Boosting nexus framework implementation in the Mediterranean

In the PRIMA BONEX project consortium, NBI is implementing Nature Based Solutions on the ground to optimize the Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystem nexus. In November, we officially started the actions of Ecological Restoration and the plantations that will allow the recovery of wetlands and watercourses in three different properties in Alentejo.







### Municipality of Santa Maria da Feira

This project focuses on **urban biodiversity**, namely measures to promote the diversity of **pollinators** in the municipality and with special relevance in the i**ndustrial areas of Santa Maria da Feira**. NBI is developing and implementing **Nature Positive action plans** in pilot areas across the municipality

# The Porto Protocol: Establish VineyardsEcosystems - Climate Talk

Nuno Gaspar de Oliveira attended the online webinar organized by The Porto Protocol Foundation, along with Tom Croghan (The Vineyards at Dodon), Emmanuel Bourguignon (LAMS-21) and Cristina Crava (The Porto Protocol). The discussion focused on practical measures for Biodiversity and Ecosystem Management in the vineyard and its surroundings, with examples from Portugal, France and the United States. The webinar also launched the first phase of the collaborative project "Living Vineyards", which aims to create a demonstration network of Ecosystem Management in vineyards across all wine regions of the world. The ambition is to be able to demonstrate that any vineyard in any part of the globe can evolve on the Nature Positive path.

### **PINUS Center**

In October, RTP launched a report in Companhia das

Lezírias, where Paulo Pereira made known the contribution
of native pine forests to the conservation of native flora,
highlighting the unique endemic species that exist here, such
as the needle armeria (Armeria pinifolia), a plant that only
exists in Portugal and is vulnerable to extinction. Nuno
Gaspar de Oliveira spoke about the economic value of the
pine forest ecosystem for the soil and landscape. This
report was released following the Jornadas ECOPINE, an
initiative of the PINUS Center held last September in
Coimbra. See the piece here and learn a little more about the
maritime pine and the Bonelli's eagle, an endangered Iberian
bird of prey, which chooses the tallest pines to nest and
eucalyptus leaves to line its nest.

Nuno Oliveira was present at the Serralves Foundation at the conference 'Encontros com Futuro' / 'Encounters with a Future' organised by REN and the Jornal O Público. The topics addressed were Natural Capital and the environmental dimension of ESG.

Paulo Pereira was in Sabugal at the 6th edition of ENERTECH, along with Sérgio Ribeiro (CEO Planetiers), Marcelo Penteado (COO Planetiers) and Jorge Cristino (author of the book "The mission of cities in the fight against climate change"). This panel talked about the challenges and opportunities of decarbonization in the context of cities and companies.
